

## Memorial and Commemorative Donations

*Memorial and Commemorative Donations are a wonderful and lasting way to honor a loved one while benefiting the community. Personalize the donation so that it is a fitting tribute: a tree for someone who loved the outdoors, aquatic scholarships in memory of someone who enjoyed swimming, senior services scholarships for someone who was an advocate for seniors, and so on.*

*Normally, all gift recognition plaques are displayed in the Robert Livermore Community Center or other appropriate community facilities. These plaques are typically bronze, 1-by-3 inches, engraved and mounted on wooden display boards. Engraved text follows a standard template including the name of the individual being memorialized, the location of the memorial item, the month and year of installation and what the memorial item is.*
